What is the vision for the combined company?

The mission and vision of Taskstream and Tk20 were remarkably well aligned and the vision of Taskstream-Tk20 follows from this. We will continue towards a shared vision to help more institutions engage in meaningful assessment practices and gather, organize, and use better data for learning.

How will this impact my use of Taskstream's or Tk20's products?

Do we need to start using a new system? When do we need to switch?

You will not be required to switch systems. We will continue to support our existing systems. As we roll out new functionality, you will be able to decide, on your own timeline, whether you want to adopt it or to continue using your current solution.

When will we start to see new development from your combined product team?

During the [webinar about the merger](#), you talked about seamless integration within your “system of systems,” but what are your plans for integrating with other systems on campus, such as student data and learning management systems?

Easier/better backend data integration with student data systems and learning management systems are high priorities for our combined product roadmap.

Do you plan to include strategic planning in addition to assessment?

Yes! While we talked a lot about assessment capabilities in our [webinar about the merger](#) — including planning, measurement, and reporting — we do plan to include strategic planning and other related functionality in our product roadmap.
