Why the EDA?

CAEP Standards require teacher preparation programs to address and assess candidate dispositions. In addition, motivation for assessing disposition is particularly helpful for teacher candidates to expedite the course of change needed to address problems associated with inappropriate attitudes and actions before and during clinical experiences.

These dispositions are aligned to standards in order to provide programs with the evidence needed to meet CAEP and state-level accreditation requirements. The EDA, LLC, structured the assessment across a 0 to 2 Likert scale, to meet and exceed the CAEP Evaluation Framework expectations. Standards addressed by the EDA include:
